
# **November Overnight Trip**

Tour the Naval Academy and attend a Navy Football Game November 16<sup>th</sup>-18th. We will be tent camping at Elk's Camp Barret. Camp Barrett is an Elks' multi-season camp facility nestled in an isolated forest of tall trees and deep ravines surprisingly located just a few minutes from the Annapolis Mall, Historic Annapolis City Dock, and the United States Naval Academy (USNA). Permission slips were due October 29th.
